



This map illustrates buffer regions around shellfish harvest and growing areas, marinas, and marine structures in relation to [Georgia House Bill 833](#). 'Anchorage restriction areas' means those areas within the estuarine areas of this state in any location that lies within 300 feet of a marina, 150 feet from a marine structure other than a marina, or within 500 feet of approved commercial shellfish growing areas and designated public harvest areas as determined by the department.
